PCAC REPORT**

May 13, 2008

Environmental Impact Report News: The re-circulated **Draft China Shipping EIR** was released April 30. A Public Scoping meeting will be held to receive comments on Thursday June 5, 6 p.m., at Banning's Landing Community Center, 100 E. Water Street in Wilmington. Written comments on the Draft EIS/EIR will be received through **June 30, 2008**. The Draft EIR was originally circulated in the Fall of 2006. Last Spring the POLA decided to scrap it and try again.

The **TraPac EIR** Public Hearing scheduled for May 15 at the POLA has been cancelled.

Clean Truck Program News: The POLA will be discussing their Clean Truck Program at Thursday's Harbor Commission Meeting, 6:00 p.m. 5/15 at the POLA headquarters. The Port is considering instituting the timetable below:

POLA concessionaires will also be responsible for providing maintenance and off street parking for the trucks, ensuring the drivers have valid TWIC cards, and the trucks have a port phone number on them for citizen complaints.

Low Sulphur Fuel News: Sadly, last week the California Air Resources Board cancelled enforcement of its new regulation for ships to use low sulphur fuels within 24nm of the California coast. The regulation was successfully appealed to the 9th Circuit Court by the Pacific Merchant Shipping Association who claims the CARB does not have jurisdiction.

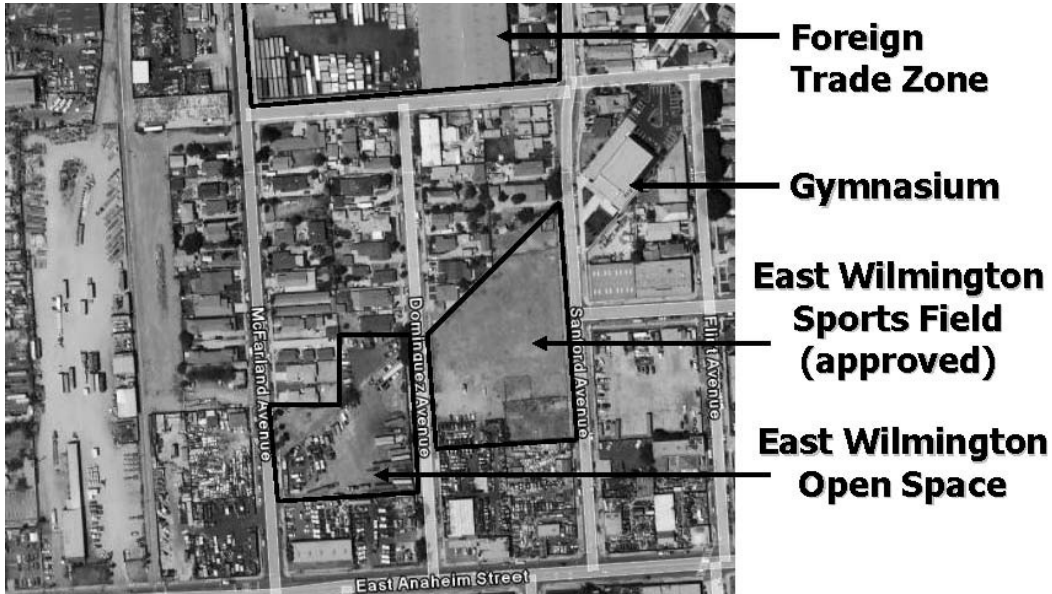

5/20/08 PCAC Meeting Agenda Items:

Action Item 1 – East Wilmington Open Space: PCAC recommends to the Board of Harbor Commissioners that the “East Wilmington Open Space, a Park” project be re-established as the highest ranked priority project as voted in the EIR/Aesthetic Mitigation Subcommittee meeting of June 28, 2007, in order to honor the true spirit and intent of the China Shipping Aesthetic Mitigation Settlement.

Action Item 2 – Port Staff Attendance at SP Coordinated Plan Subcommittee Meetings: PCAC recommend to the Board of Harbor Commissioners that Port staff representatives attend the San Pedro Coordinated Plan Subcommittee and all other PCAC Subcommittee meetings to address and discuss agenda items.

Action Item 3 - Ports O' Call Enhancements: PCAC recommends that the Board of Harbor Commissioners direct Port staff to implement the original Ports O' Call enhancement project.

Action Item 4 – PCAC By-laws: Changes in by-laws defining a quorum as 50% of the voting members, and changes in voting procedures to be a majority vote of members present, the Chair is to abstain from voting except to break a tie, alternates may not vote when the designated voting member is present, no proxy votes are to be allowed, and conflict of interest prohibiting affected member from discussing or voting the issue in question.
